White Lake will act on construction bids

March 26, 2012

The White Lake board of education will deal with a full agenda Tuesday as it moves toward an April ground-breaking for its community recreation center and gymnasium project.

The board will convene at 6 p.m. in the school library.

The \$3.5 million building project, approved by voters in November, has been consuming much of the board's attention and this month members are scheduled to take action on construction bids.

Engineer Doc Smith of EDS Builders will review the progress toward a mid-April ground-breaking and the board will also be updated on the unique community log donation program that is providing the wood for the new gymnasium's floor.

In other action items, the board will review plans for the summer food service program and hire an assistant junior high volleyball coach, and varsity and assistant softball coaches. The resignations of the people now filling those positions will be accepted earlier in the evening under the consent agenda.

Action is also scheduled on contracts with Cooperative Educational Service Agencies No. 8 and 9, which provide a variety of ancillary services to the district.

The board will also look at the 2012-13 school calendar and get its first look at policies on new board member orientation and weapons on school premises.

Following the open meeting, the panel will reconvene in closed session to discuss support staff negotiations.
