The White Lake School's new community recreation center is under cover, and the floor for the gymnasium has been poured. Crews from Osborn Roofing are shown working on the roof on the gymnasium. It's a busy site, with McGivern Masonry personnel laying brick on the exterior walls and

working on interior block partitions. Smith Concrete poured the gymnasium floor, about 11,500 square feet of space on Friday, using a laser screed to keep the concrete as level as possible and within tolerance. Doc Smith of EDS Builders said the \$3 million project is about a week or two ahead and things are looking good. "Overall everything is coming together nicely and the contractors are doing a great job," Smith said.
